Plans for Program Continuity

A virtual format, using Google Classroom or teacher websites, will be our primary method of delivery.

Hard copies will be provided for those families that cannot access resources virtually. We understand the pressures on families during these challenging times and thank you again for your patience as we make this transition from classroom instruction to the virtual environment.
