

Dear EPC Families,

Thank you for your patience during this time. This week has allowed us to better understand this situation and how it will affect your child's education. Alberta Education continues to update us on decisions being made at their level. We will continue to forward this information to our families. I will pass on some information before we leave for spring break.

1. All students will be receiving school work in their core courses: Science, Social Studies, Math and English (and French Language Arts where applicable). If a core course is required for graduation, we will continue to offer it. This will be available on **MONDAY, MARCH 30, 2020**. Hard copies will be available, in one-week portions, for pick up in the front foyer starting at 12:00 noon every Monday. Virtual learning will be accessible to students in one-week portions starting Monday morning of each week.
2. We have contacted all families by phone and/or email to discuss what format (virtual or hard copy) you would prefer moving forward. If you have not communicated this to the school please do so at 780-675-2285.
3. If you have not done so already, please plan to come into the school the week of March 30-April 3 from 9:30-3:00pm to retrieve your child's personal items and return textbooks and other school items. We would like this completed by April 3rd at the latest. We ask for the following procedure to take place when entering the school.
 - Parents/students come individually not as groups
 - Sign in and wash hands with sanitizer
 - Go straight to your locker
 - Sign out and leave via the front door
4. The Junior High trip to Eastern Canada has been cancelled. Aspen View's board of trustees passed a motion yesterday, at their board meeting, making this decision. We have had brief contact with the tour company and more information will be shared with families upon our return to work after spring break.
5. Diploma and PAT Exams have been officially cancelled for this year. More information to follow once we have received clarification and details.
6. Please continue to check the EPC webpage and Facebook page for updated information.
7. Most importantly, we would like our families to focus on their physical and mental health as we navigate this new learning environment.

Spring break is next week, March 23-27, so there will be no staff present at the school. If you have any questions please contact us on Monday, March 30th.
