Value

Each year, one Edwin Parr Composite High School (E.P.C) student from Athabasca, Alberta may receive a single \$500 award.

Eligibility

Applicants from E.P.C. must be pursuing studies leading to an apprenticeship recognized in the Pulp and Paper Industry: Electrical, Instrumentation, Heavy Equipment Operator/Technician, Mechanical, Millwright Power Engineer, Steamfitter/Pipefitter, Welder.

Selection Process

Staff from E.P.C. will make up the selection committee. The committee will review all applications and will determine the successful applicant based on a satisfactory performance in the following:

Academics, Leadership Capabilities and Skills, and Community Involvement.

Application Process

All completed applications must be submitted to the E.P.C. Student Services Department. Once a successful candidate has been chosen by the Selection Committee, the successful candidate's application can be emailed to community.relations@alpac.ca. Al-Pac's funding deadline is June 30.

Award Presentation

When possible, an Al-Pac representative will present the award at the graduation ceremonies. When not possible, an E.P.C. staff member is asked to present on Al-Pac's behalf.
