EPC Student Council is proud to have fundraised to support this organization.



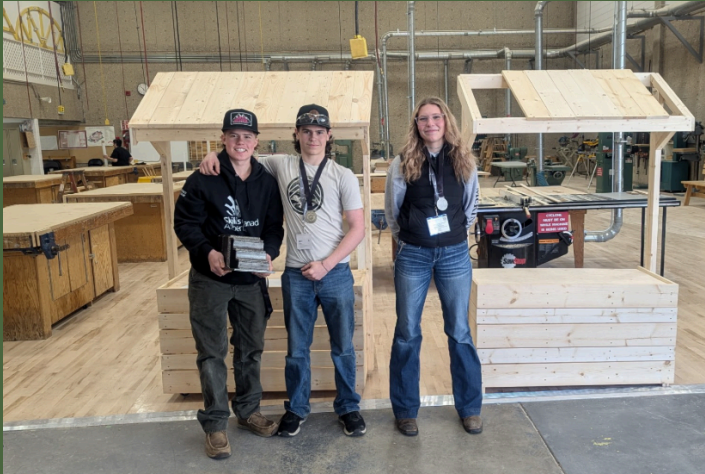

✨ EPC's European Adventure: A Journey to Remember! ✨

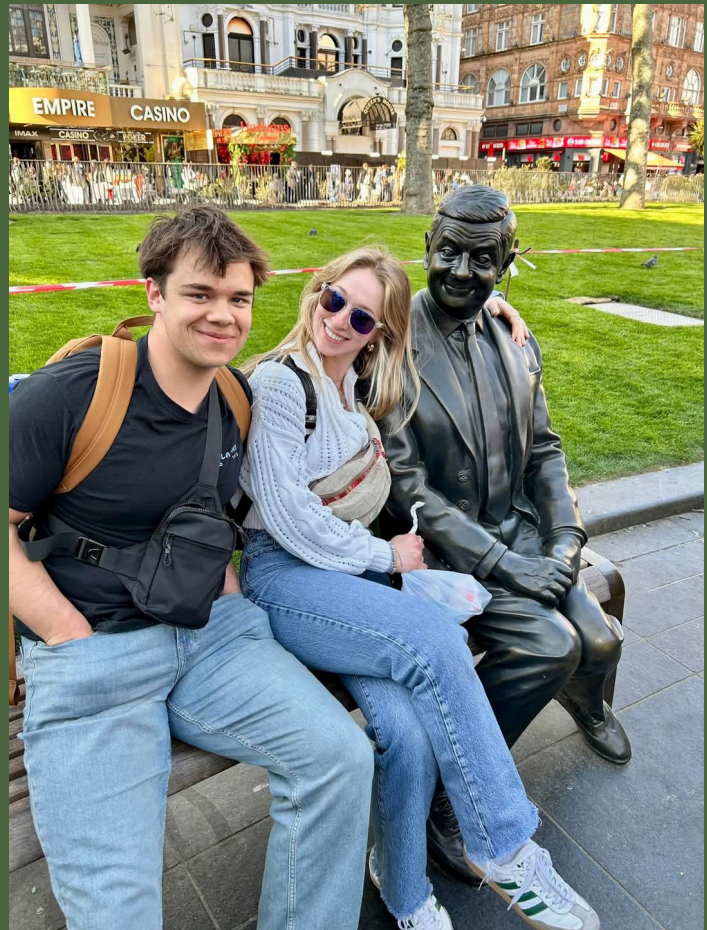
