The Grade 12 potluck was a fantastic way to kick off the Easter break! It was a great opportunity for classmates to relax, enjoy good food, and make lasting memories together.



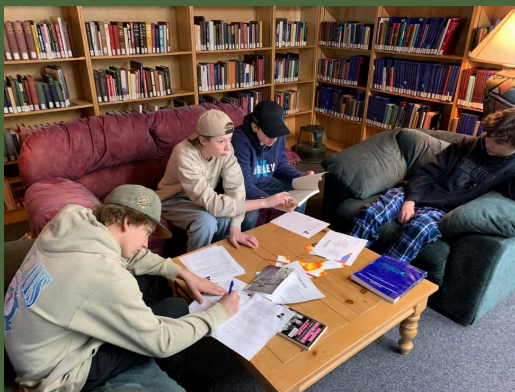

This hands-on activity allowed them to use the concepts of similar shapes and ratios to calculate the heights of objects that were too tall for them to measure directly. It was a fantastic way to apply math in a real-world context!

Saturday, May 24th, 2025 at the Multiplex

Friday, May 23rd Set-up of Multiplex (Fieldhouse and EPC Gymnasium)

All grade 12 students will be excused from classes for the school day to help with set-up at the multiplex and school gym.

Friday, May 23rd at 1:30 pm: Grad Rehearsal

All Grads must attend as a lot of information regarding how things will run on that Saturday in terms of seating, walk-in, and so on will be covered. Depending on the group and if everyone is reasonably on time this should take an hour to complete.

Saturday, May 24th: Graduation Day

- 2:00 pm: The doors to the Field House will open to the public to settle into their seats.
- 2:40 pm: All Grads will assemble in the Arena portion of the Multiplex to get in line for the walk-in for the ceremony.
- 3:00 pm: The Grad ceremony will start, with the walk-in of the Grads
- 4:45 pm – 5:00 pm: The Grad ceremony will be concluded.
- 5:20 pm: All Grads will assemble in the Field House of the Multiplex to get in line for the walk over for the parade.
- 5:30 pm: The Grad Parade to EPC.
- 5:30 - 9:00 pm The Celebration - Prom 2025 at EPC.
- This is a graduating student only event. Graduating students can attend and bring an escort/guest. The escorts/guests will need pre-approval from Admin if they do not attend our school. Escorts/guests are not over 19 years of age and must be in at least grade 10.
- Parents are invited to join their Grad for the first portion of the evening for photo-ops, parent / grad dances, etc.. but will be asked to leave within that first hour (6:30pm) so that the Grads and their escorts can resume the remainder of the event.
